**LET IT BE KNOWN TO ALL PERSONS** that the County of Indiana has designated a Fair Housing Officer, Christina Coleman, Community Development Analyst of the Indiana County Office of Planning & Development as the Fair Housing Officer for Indiana County and the Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Communities of Indiana Borough and Center Township; and

**WHEREAS**, Indiana County and Indiana County "on behalf of" Indiana Borough and Center Township have adopted a complaint process to assist all residents of the County that encounter discriminatory acts in the following actions, if based on race, color, sex, national origin, religion, familial status (families with children), or handicap (disability) is prohibited by Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Federal Fair Housing Law) and the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act adds the additional protected classes of age, ancestry and use of guide or support animals and local laws and ordinances.

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the County of Indiana shall make publicly known through this resolution, advertisement and website posting the process to file a complaint or grievance for assistance when discrimination in housing activities is suspected.
