

**Public Hearing Notice and
Proposed Project Selection for the 2017 CDBG Program
Indiana County “on behalf of” Indiana Borough**

Notice is hereby given by Indiana County “on behalf of” Indiana Borough that it will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, October 3, 2017 at 6:30 PM in the Indiana Borough Municipal Building located at 80 N 8th Street, Indiana, Pennsylvania. This meeting is accessible to individuals with disabilities and/or for persons with Limited English Proficiency. The purpose of the public hearing is to discuss the 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project selection and the 3-Yr Plan for Indiana County “on behalf of” Indiana Borough. The hearing will also solicit input on the activities, the selection of activities and why any proposed activities were not selected for funding. The selected 2017 CDBG activities are to undertake improvements to the First Street Retention Pond Improvements; other priority areas for storm water management purposes; development of a storm water management plan and administration.

The County of Indiana “on behalf of” Indiana Borough will receive an allocation of \$162,177.00 of 2017 CDBG funds from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. In addition, the County of Indiana “on behalf of” Indiana Borough anticipates the receipt of no program income during the 2017 program year. The proposed activities will benefit at least 51% low-moderate income persons in the service area to qualify as a low-moderate income project. The PA Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) has announced the application submission deadline of November 3, 2017.

If the County of Indiana “on behalf of” Indiana Borough would undertake activities that result in the displacement of families or individuals, then the County of Indiana’s policy for minimizing such displacement would be in effect. The County of Indiana “on behalf of” Indiana Borough is responsible for replacing all low and moderate income housing units that may be demolished or converted as a result of the use of CDBG funds.

All interested citizen are encouraged to attend and will be offered the opportunity to give oral testimony at the public hearing and/or to present written comments concerning the proposed CDBG activities and 3-Year Plan of Indiana County “on behalf of” Indiana Borough, the project selection process and any other questions related to the CDBG program.
