

**Public Hearing Notice and
Proposed Project Selection for the 2018 CDBG Program
Indiana County “on behalf of” Burrell Township**

Notice is hereby given by Indiana County “on behalf of” Burrell Township that it will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, September 19, 2018 at 6:30 PM in the Burrell Township Municipal Building located at 321 Park Drive, Black Lick, Pennsylvania. This meeting is accessible to individuals with disabilities and/or for persons with Limited English Proficiency. The purpose of the public hearing is to discuss the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project selection and the 3-Yr Plan for Indiana County “on behalf of” Burrell Township. The hearing will discuss the selection of activities and why any proposed activities were not selected for funding. The selected 2018 CDBG activities are to undertake sanitary sewer system improvements in the Josephine area and storm sewer improvements in the Marshall Heights area of Burrell Township.

The County of Indiana “on behalf of” Burrell Township is expected to receive an allocation of approximately \$92,257.00 of 2018 CDBG funds from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. In addition, the County of Indiana “on behalf of” Burrell Township anticipates the receipt of no program income during the 2018 program year. At least 70% of the available funding must be used for activities which benefit low and moderate income persons. The proposed activities must benefit at least 51% low-moderate income persons in the service area to qualify as a low-moderate income project. The PA Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) has announced the application submission deadline of November 2, 2018.

If the County of Indiana “on behalf of” Burrell Township would undertake activities that result in the displacement of families or individuals, then the County of Indiana’s policy for minimizing such displacement would be in effect. The County of Indiana “on behalf of” Burrell Township is responsible for replacing all low and moderate income housing units that may be demolished or converted as a result of the use of CDBG funds.

All interested citizen are encouraged to attend and will be offered the opportunity to give oral testimony at the public hearing and/or to present written comments concerning the proposed CDBG activities and 3-Yr Plan, the selection process and any other questions related to the CDBG program.
